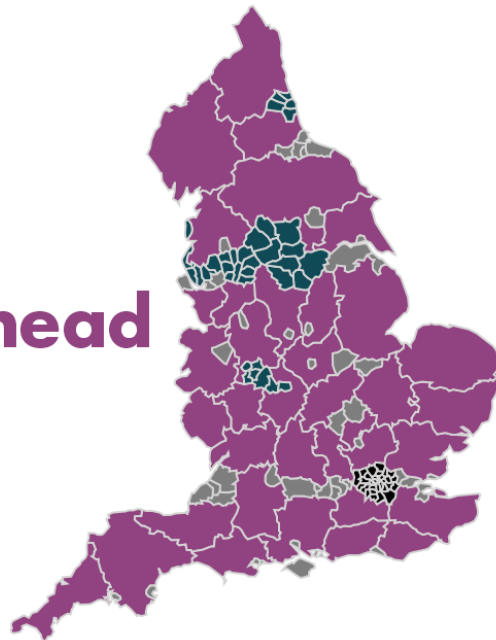

Counties receive
£249 per head
for key services

London receives
£550 per head
for key services

Met boroughs receive
£407 per head
for key services

Non-CCN unitaries receive
£334 per head
for key services

The impact...



The social care crisis is most intense in counties

Counties receive

£439 less

per elderly resident compared to inner London



There is a council tax disparity across the country

The average county bill is

£1,600

compared to £1,141 for inner London



School budgets are under significant pressures

Counties receive

£2,048 less

per pupil compared to inner London

The Government's fair funding review could address these inequities

Any new system must be based on genuine cost drivers, not a regressive formula. CCN is calling for it to be accelerated to address the severe funding pressures faced by counties.
